#### What will be covered?

- competitor vehicle checking
- competitor paperwork checking
- the hill control unit
- timekeeping
- rescue unit
- recovery unit
- various aspects of the course (hill)
- competitor paddock
- start-line
- the marshal posts that have specific functions

### What time will I be required?

Speed events - hillclimbs and sprints - between 7am-8am for "signing on"
An event will usually finish between 5pm-6pm



## What clothing should I wear?

- casual outdoor wear arms and legs must be covered
- suitable footwear for walking the countryside
- waterproofs

#### What else do I need?

- water
- snacks some events will provide a free lunch

#### What is the minimum age?

- 11 years old you will need to be accompanied by a parent/guardian for the day.
- All marshals that are under 18 years of age must be signed on using an "under 18 signingon form", which must be countersigned by the marshal's parent or guardian.



All volunteer's are always very welcome, and you will be gaining experience with every event that you attend.
